Jaguar to go back on exhibit

Wailer, the Abilene Zoo's popular jaguar will be back on exhibit for Spring Break.

The big cat was off exhibit for a few weeks during the renovation of his night quarters.

At almost 20 years of age, Wailer is one of the oldest jaguars in captivity.

The Abilene Zoo is home to more than 900 animals from 250 species. The zoo is open 7 days a week (closed Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day) from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Last admittance is 4 p.m. Tickets are \$6 for adults, \$3.50 for children ages 3-12, \$5 for seniors aged 60+.
