ABILENE, TEXAS – Celebrate dad this Sunday with a family trip to the Abilene Zoo.

All fathers will get in free with a paying child, even grown children, on Father's Day, June 21.

The first 100 fathers through the gate will receive a coupon for a family value pack at Abilene's Cold Stone Creamery location.

Visitors will have the opportunity to see many future dads -- including the several male flamingos who are currently assisting in incubating seven different eggs, the male maned wolf who was recently reintroduced to the female in the hopes of producing pups this fall, and a new one year old male zebra who has joined the zoo's three females to begin a new breeding program

.About the Abilene Zoo:

The Abilene Zoo is home to more than 900 animals of 250 different species. The zoo is open 7 days a week (closed Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day) from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Last admittance is 4 p.m. Tickets are \$6 for adults, \$3.50 for children ages 3-12, \$5 for seniors aged 60+. Members are admitted free. Memberships start at \$30.
